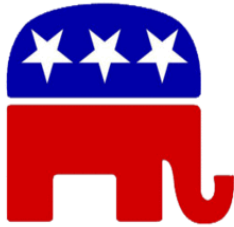

President's Message

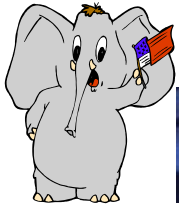
Happy New Year to all BARW members!
