# Campaign Activities

In these strange Covid times you may be at a loss for ways to help get Republicans Elected. Normal Campaign Activities are not taking place as in previous years. Fear not! Go to the TFRW website ([www.tfrw.org](http://www.tfrw.org)) click on the programs tab and look for "RED Dialer Program". This program will allow you to make calls for candidates from your home. Many campaigns have similar programs so if you have a favorite candidate give them a call. Offer to help. You can also head to the polls and wave you favorite campaign sign. Think outside the box! It should be the 2020 motto.

I have attached a list of the Early Voting Locations in Clear Lake and the surrounding area in this Newsletter. It is important to note that the Freeman Library is NOT an early voting location. Please spread the word to everyone you know. We don't want Republican voters to go to the library, get discouraged and not vote. If none of these locations are near you, go to [www.harrisvotes.com](http://www.harrisvotes.com). Under the Polling Locations tab there is a "find nearest polling location" box where you can enter your address and find the location closest to you. You can get the nearest location on Election Day by sliding the tab at the top from Early Voting to Election Day. It appears as of now, that the Freeman Library will be a voting location on Election Day.

Go prepared. Check out your ballot ahead of time. You may bring a sample ballot with you. To find your ballot: go to the home page at [www.harrisvotes.com](http://www.harrisvotes.com) click on the "Sample Ballot" tab, type in your name and street address and your ballot will come up. Remember, there is **no straight ticket** voting. So go prepared to have to vote individually for every candidate! Vote the WHOLE ballot. Remember, due to Covid all the May small city elections are on this ballot at the very end. That includes School Board and Trustee elections as well as the Clear Lake City Water Authority.

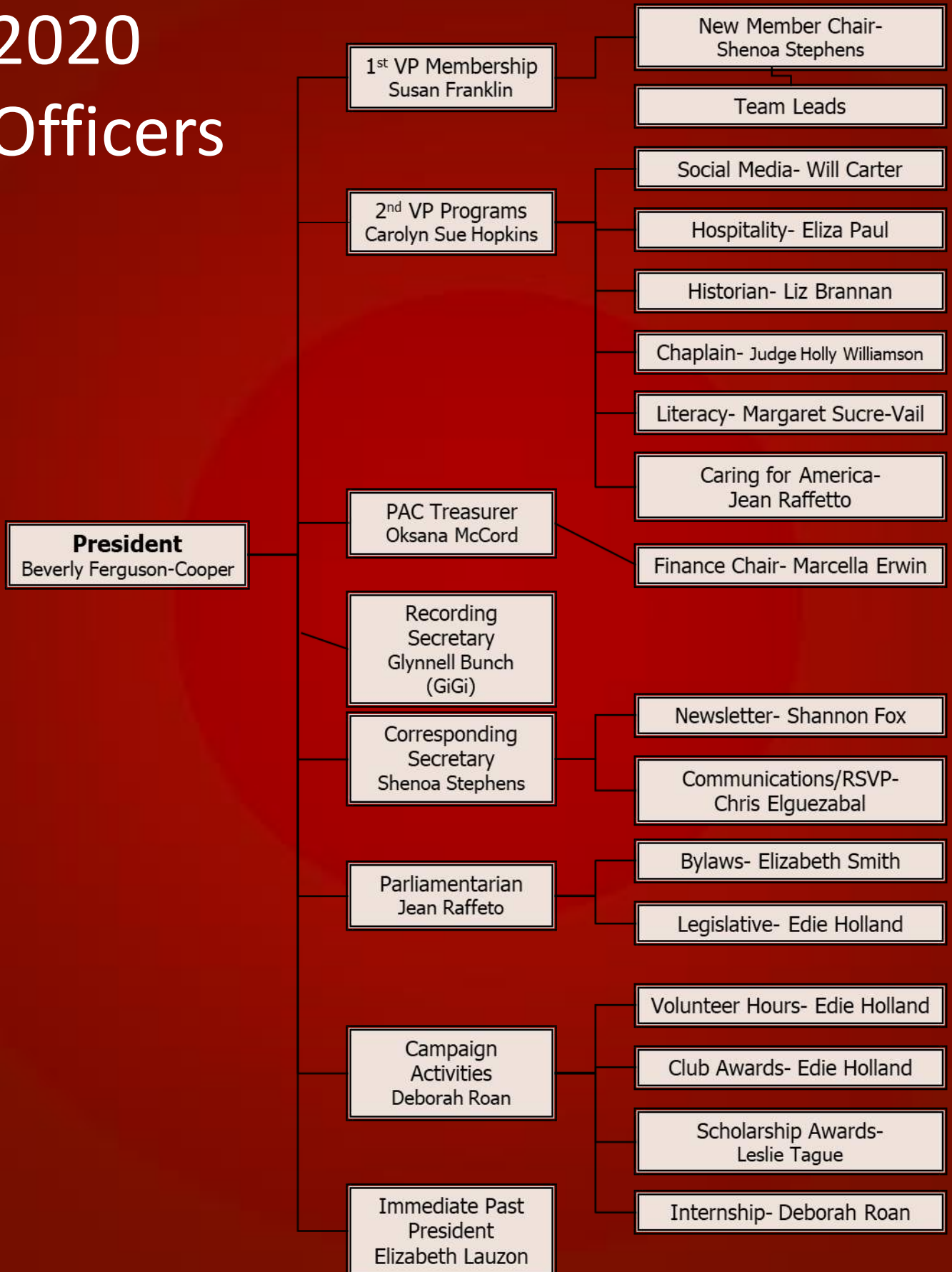
