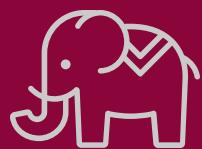
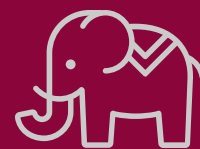

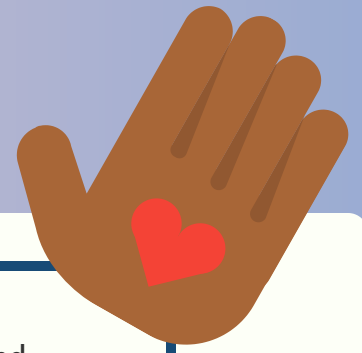

Important dates for the upcoming School Board and Small City Elections:

April 1st	Last day to register to vote for the May elections
April 19th	Early voting begins
April 20th	Last day to get a Ballot by Mail
April 27th	Last day of early voting
May 1st	Election Day (Uniform Election/School Board)

Also, returning members must rejoin BARW by March 1st in order to be eligible to attend the TFRW Convention (Oct. 12th – 16th) as a delegate. New members may join up until August 13th to be eligible to attend.

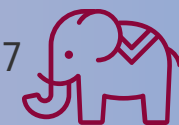

Jerome and Sam will focus on the following:

Want to keep Texas “Texan”? The Texas Public Policy Foundation can help! Texas lawmakers have an incredible opportunity to use the [Liberty Action Agenda](#) as a guide to promote and defend liberty, personal responsibility, and free enterprise in Texas. Jerome Greener and Sam Pohl will be joining us on Tuesday, February 23, 2021, to discuss how Texans can civically engage with their lawmakers to eliminate tax dollars being utilized to fund lobbyists, strengthening our election system so that other states look to Texas to replicate, ensuring that the right to self-defense is not infringed, and much more.

Jerome joined the Foundation as Vice President of Engagement in November 2020. In his role, Jerome leads engagement efforts to connect Texans with opportunities that will help them live their best version of the American Dream. Prior to joining the Foundation, Jerome served as the Texas State Director for Americans for Prosperity where he orchestrated grass root communities to advocate for \$7.6 billion in tax relief. Jerome also helped found a Facebook gaming company that empowered social gamers to generate real funds for a humanitarian aid project in Africa. Jerome earned a B.A in Politics and an M.B.A from the University of Dallas. A San Antonio native, Jerome now resides in North Texas with his wife, Jennifer.



Sam Pohl joined Texas Public Policy Foundation in May of 2020, and serves as the Director of External Relations. As a 6th generation Texan, Sam is passionate about the Lone Star State and advancing Liberty. He has a background in political campaigning in both Texas and Florida.
