Highlights from February Meeting



Houston, we have a problem...

Andy Kahn, Director of Victim Services and Advocacy for Crime Stoppers of Houston, shared a message about the rising murder rate in the city of Houston due, in part, to a bond pandemic. In an interview with KTRK, Mr. Khan said "What we are seeing and what we're trying to get people to talk about is the revolving door at the courthouse that continues to release offenders time and time again. This is collateral damage of what we're seeing in bond reform."

Andy Khan made his point by holding a poster filled with pictures of victims. One of the stories he shared was that of an eighty-year-old grandmother stabbed to death in a Walgreen's parking lot. She was murdered by a career criminal who was out on bond having been arrested 67 times previously. This is an example of the violent crime committed by serious, violent criminals, many of whom are on low bonds for violent serious felonies, who are being set free by our legal system, only to commit more

felonies, including murder.


