BARW Purpose

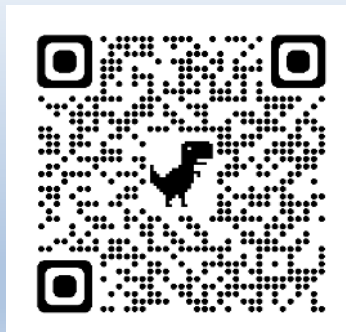

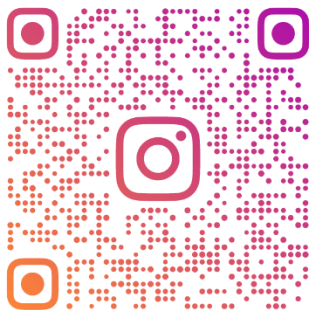
