

Come on in – The border is closed!

Gov. Greg Abbott traveled to the Rio Grande Valley on Monday to sign into law three bills that pour more money into his three-year effort to deter illegal immigration at the Texas-Mexico border and give Texas law enforcement authority to arrest undocumented immigrants anywhere in the state.

<u>Senate Bill 3</u> earmarks \$1.54 billion in state money to continue construction of barriers along the 1,200-mile border, and allows the state to spend up to \$40 million for state troopers to patrol <u>Colony Ridge</u>, a housing <u>development</u> near Houston that far-right publications claim is a magnet for undocumented immigrants.

The money would be added to at least \$1.5 billion in contracts the state has issued since September 2021 to build about 40 miles of border barrier. As of August, Texas had erected 16 miles of steel bollard barriers in Starr, Cameron, Val Verde and Webb counties.

<u>Senate Bill 4</u> creates a state crime for illegally crossing the border from Mexico — a new law that is likely to force a legal showdown with the federal government.

Another Senate Bill 4 — this one passed by lawmakers during the third special session earlier this year — would increase the minimum sentence from two years to 10 years for smuggling immigrants or operating a stash house.



Leave the World Behind is a 2023 American apocalyptic psychological thriller film written and directed by Sam Esmail. It is based on the 2020 novel by Rumaan Alam. The film stars Julia Roberts, Mahershala Ali, Ethan Hawke, Myha'la, and Kevin Bacon as they attempt to make sense of the gradual breakdown in phones, television, and other regularly used technology which points to a potential cataclysm.

Leave the World Behind had its world premiere at the <u>AFI Fest</u> on October 25, 2023. It was released in <u>select theaters</u> on November 22, 2023, before its streaming release by <u>Netflix</u> on December 8, 2023. It received generally positive reviews from critics.


