During his last term in the Texas House, Mayes served as Chairman of the Texas House Freedom Caucus.

Now in the Texas Senate, Mayes represents Senate District 11, encompassing portions of Brazoria, Galveston, and Harris Counties. Throughout his time in both the House and Senate, Mayes has consistently ranked among the top most conservative members of the Legislature. Senator Middleton currently serves as the Vice Chairman of the Subcommittee on Higher Education and as a member on the Senate Committees on Administration, Business & Commerce, Education, Jurisprudence, and State Affairs.

Representative Paul is currently serving in his fourth legislative session. Currently, he serves as a member of the House Natural Resources Committee and as a member of the House Committee on Insurance.








"So many times, almost on a daily basis, I hear people talking about wanting to go back to the old days of Mitt Romney, Cheney, the Bushes, you know, when Republicans could reset themselves back to these people that were steady and spoke perfectly. Yet they're the ones who created the swamp that we have to deal with now," Noem told Fox News Digital.

"So this book is almost like a get over it and grow up book and the to-do book for the average citizen on what they can do to embrace the fact that we're not going back to that," she added. "There's no going back. They need to adjust their perspective and realize that Trump broke politics – he just did – and that that's a good thing."

Mr. Munisteri began by urging unifying the Republican party and sticking to a conservative agenda. He also cited legislative wins that the Republicans in Texas has achieved, such as making abortion illegal in Texas, banning inappropriate books from the shelves of Texas elementary schools, securing more ground in promoting election integrity, and pursing safe and closed borders.


Keep in mind how much the cost of food and gasoline has gone up when making your donation.
